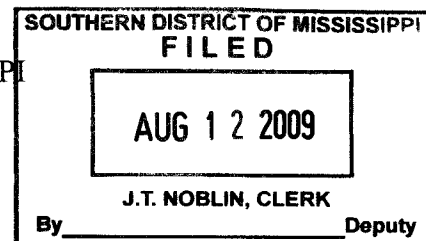

SCHEDULING ORDER

Defendant having entered a plea of not guilty in this matter, the above case has been set for **JURY/BENCH TRIAL** at 10:00 A.M., on **October 5, 2009** in Courtroom 583 of the Dan M. Russell, Jr. United States Courthouse, 2012 15th Street, Gulfport, Mississippi before **United States Senior District Judge Walter J. Gex III**.

Pertinent schedule dates are as follows:

Non-dispositive motion deadline: August 31, 2009

Dispositive motion deadline: September 7, 2009

Change of plea notification deadline: September 17, 2009

Jury Instructions; Exhibit/Witness lists: September 30, 2009

I. Change of Plea

Should a Defendant desire to change his/her plea to guilty, counsel for Defendant shall file the appropriate notice of intent to change plea via CM/ECF by no later than **September 17, 2009**. **ALL PLEAS AFTER SEPTEMBER 17, 2009 SHALL BE OPEN PLEAS UNLESS A TIMELY MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF THAT DEADLINE IS RECEIVED AND GRANTED BY THE COURT.** Requests for extension shall be made prior **September 17, 2009**.

NO EXTENSION OF THIS DEADLINE MAY BE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS OFFICE. No extension shall be granted except for meritorious good cause as determined by the Court.

II. Dispositive Motions

Dispositive motions must be filed by no later than **September 7, 2009**. All motions and related pleadings are to be filed electronically via CM/ECF in accordance with the rules of this Court. The United States shall file a response or notify the Court of no forthcoming response within seven (7) days of the motion filing date. Defendant shall file a rebuttal or notify the Court of no forthcoming rebuttal within three (3) days of the filing of the United States' response.

NO EXTENSION OF THESE DEADLINES MAY BE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS OFFICE. No extension shall be granted except for meritorious and good cause as determined by the Court.

Dispositive motions shall be decided on the memoranda of authorities unless the Court decides otherwise. Should the court determine the necessity of a hearing, the parties will be notified and a hearing date scheduled prior to the beginning of the trial calendar.


III. Non-Dispositive Motions

All non-dispositive motions must be filed by no later than **August 31, 2009**, and, if a hearing is deemed necessary by the court, will be heard by United States Magistrate Judge (*) on a date to be scheduled by the magistrate judge unless resolved by the United States and defense counsel prior thereto. If the moving party fails to appear for the hearing on the date set, the court shall consider the motion(s) moot and an order shall be entered accordingly. Counsel may seek an earlier expedited hearing on any non-dispositive motion by consulting with the magistrate judge's office and opposing counsel to obtain a mutually acceptable hearing date. Motions and related pleadings shall be filed as detailed above.


IV. Proposed Jury Instructions, Witness Lists, Exhibit Lists


